



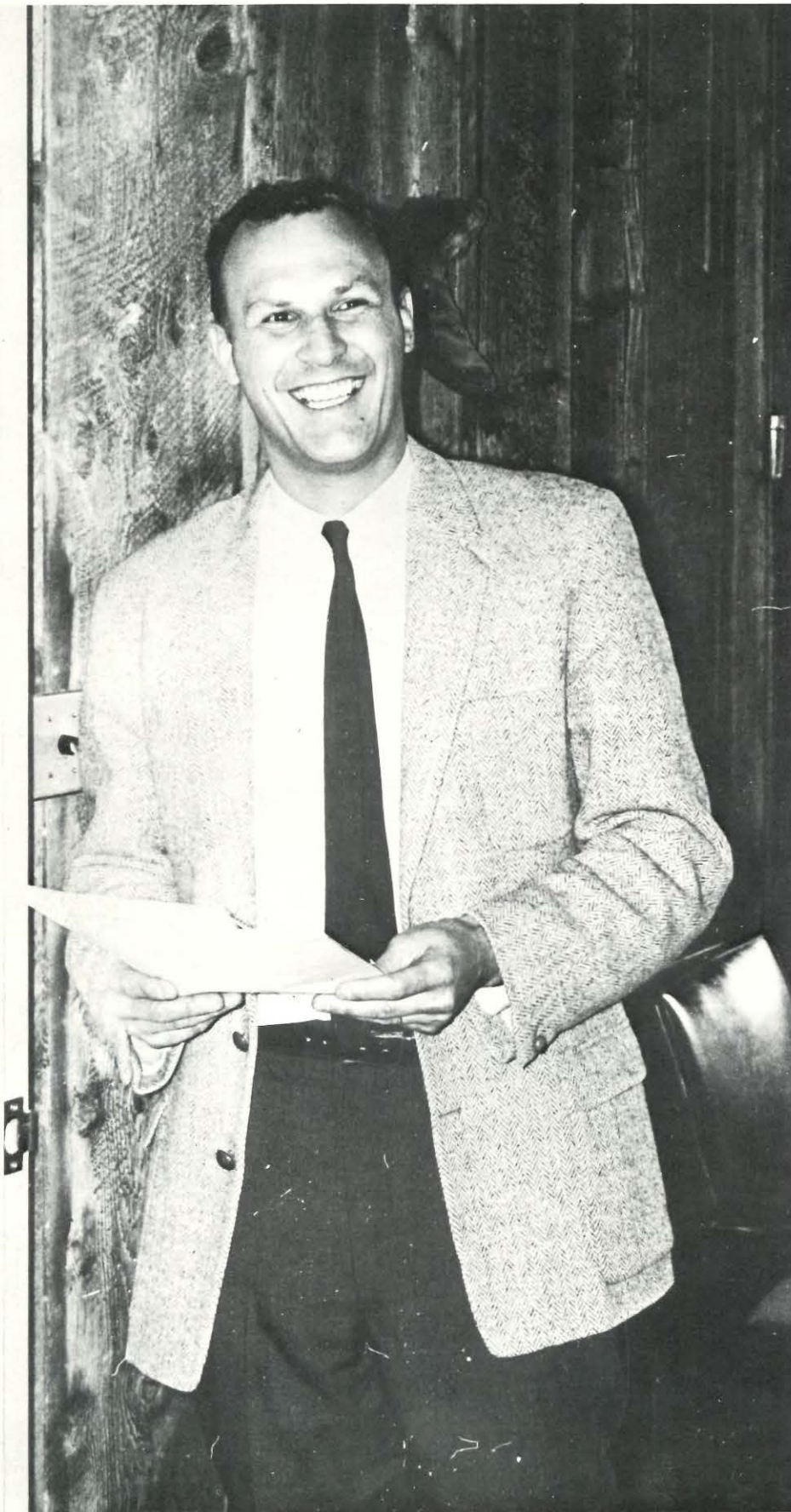

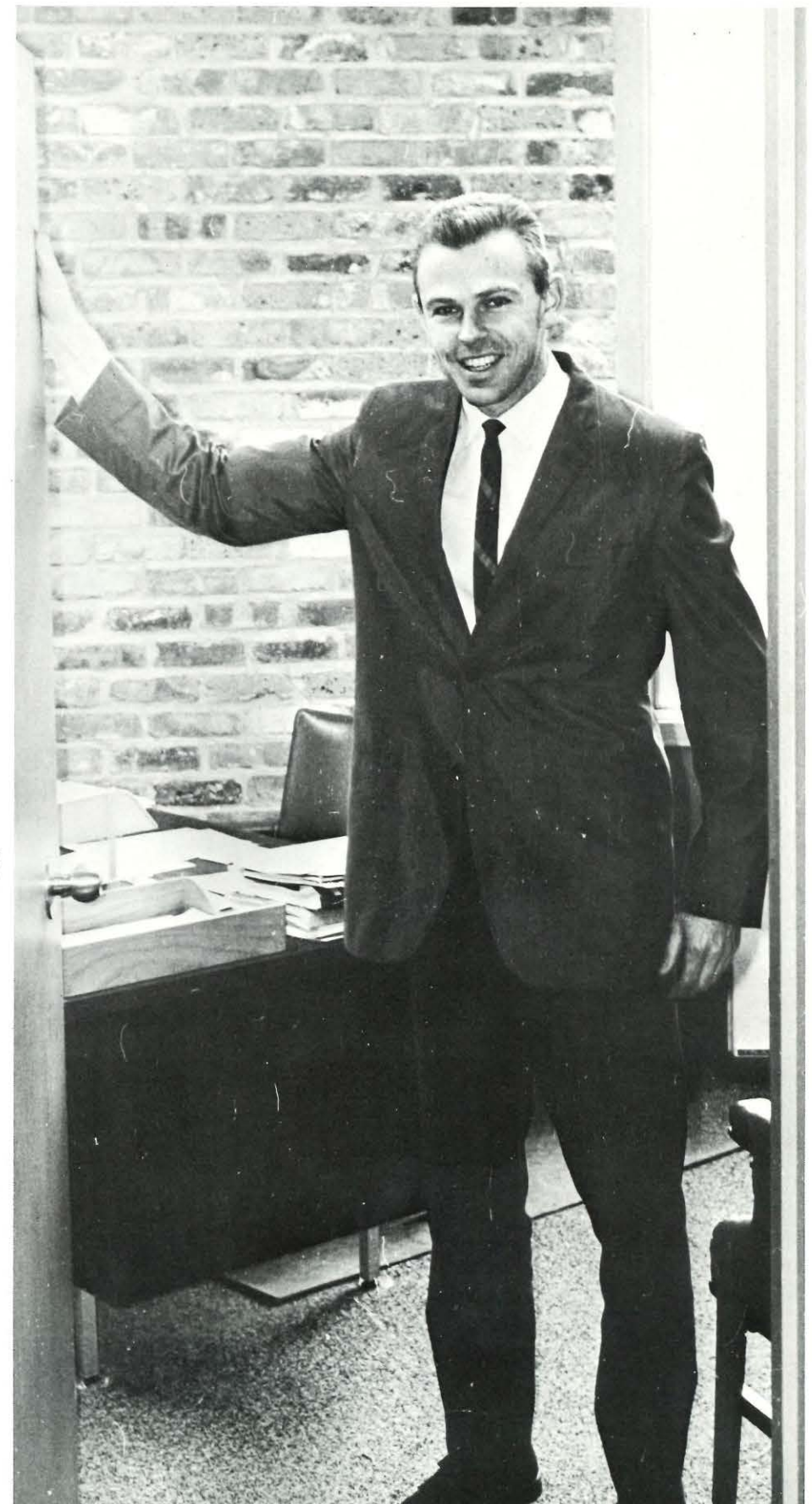

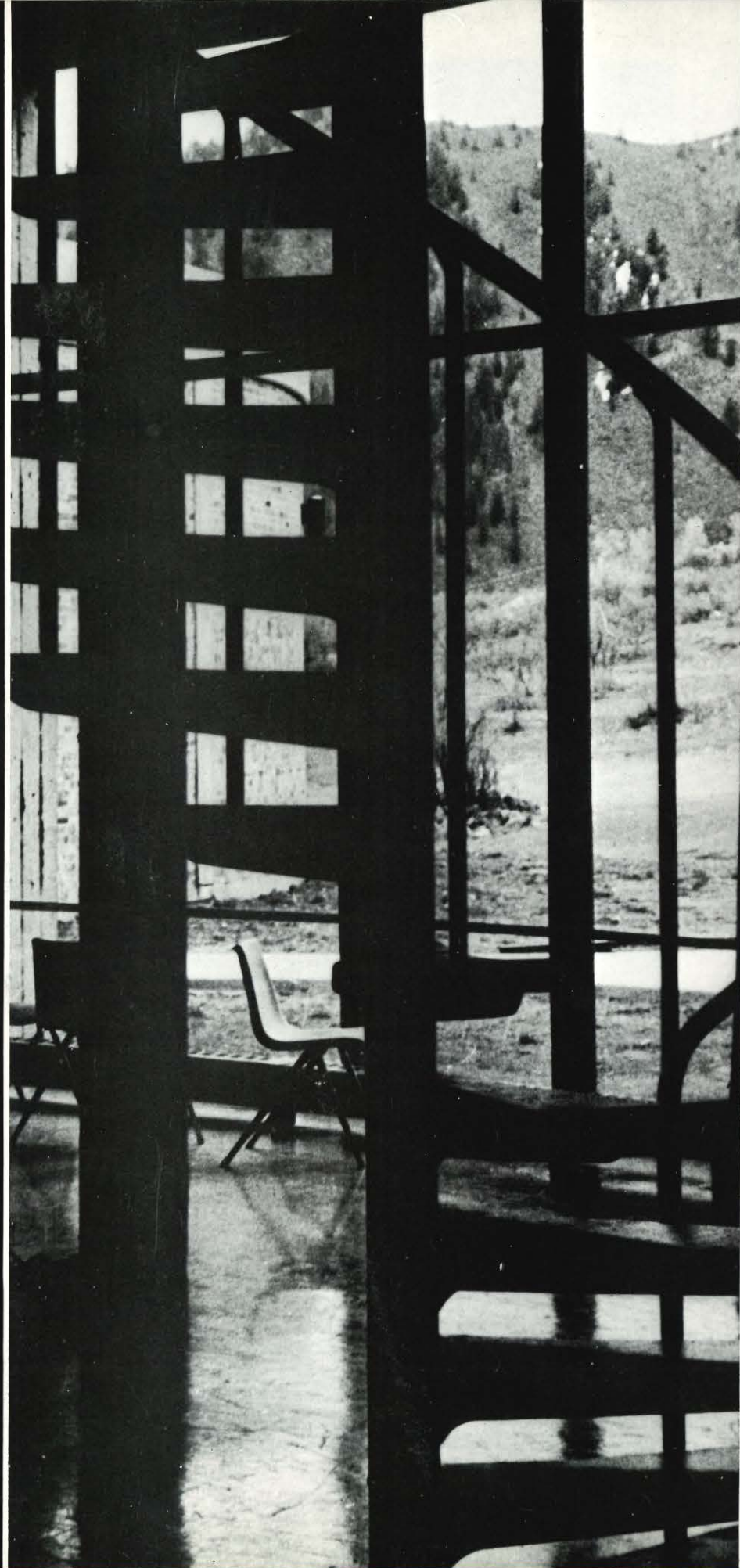

"...I had to learn to study and do things on my own..."

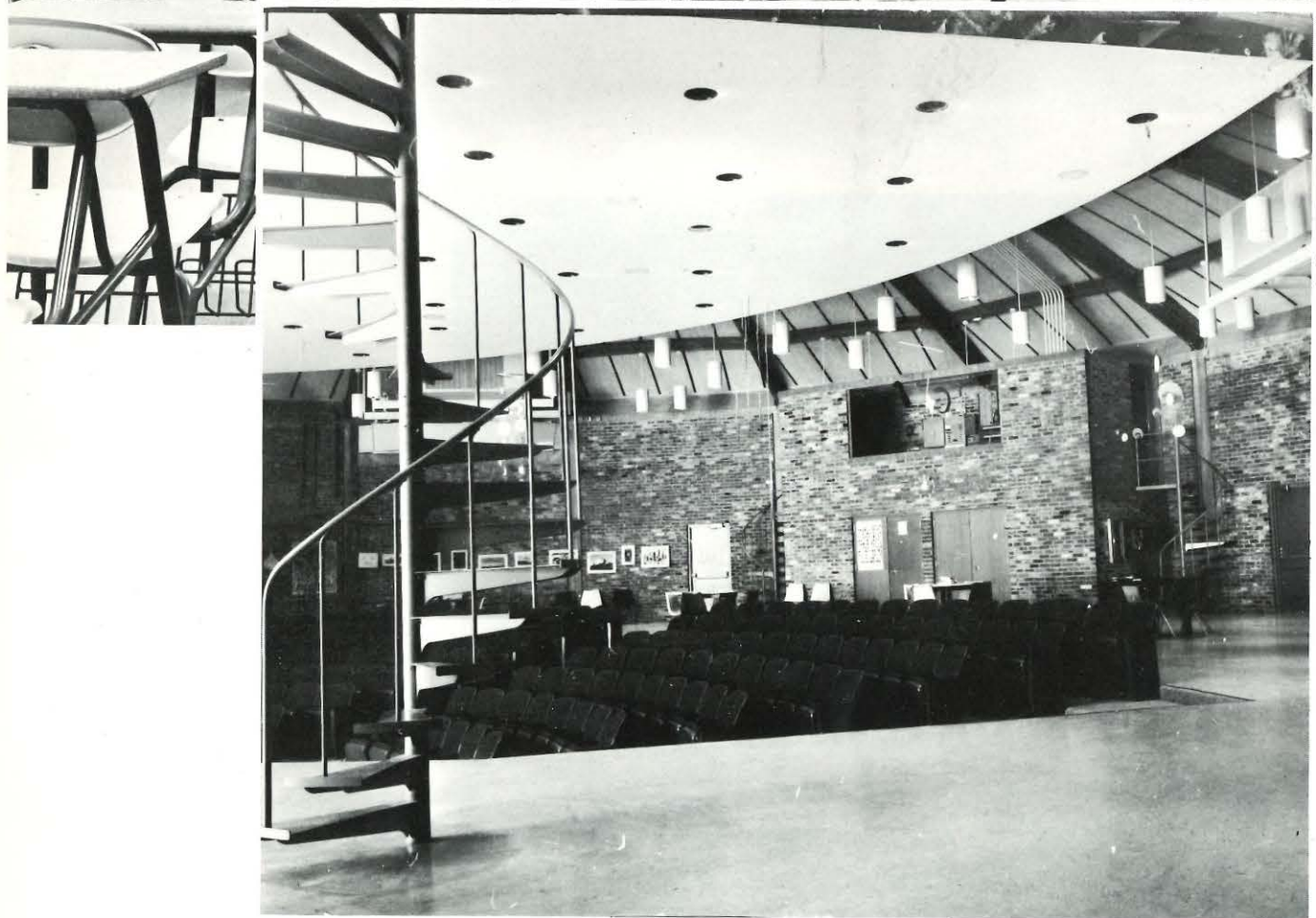
"...I hope they don't make this mistake again..."
