I am grasping for more air, more life, but there's nothing to hold on to.

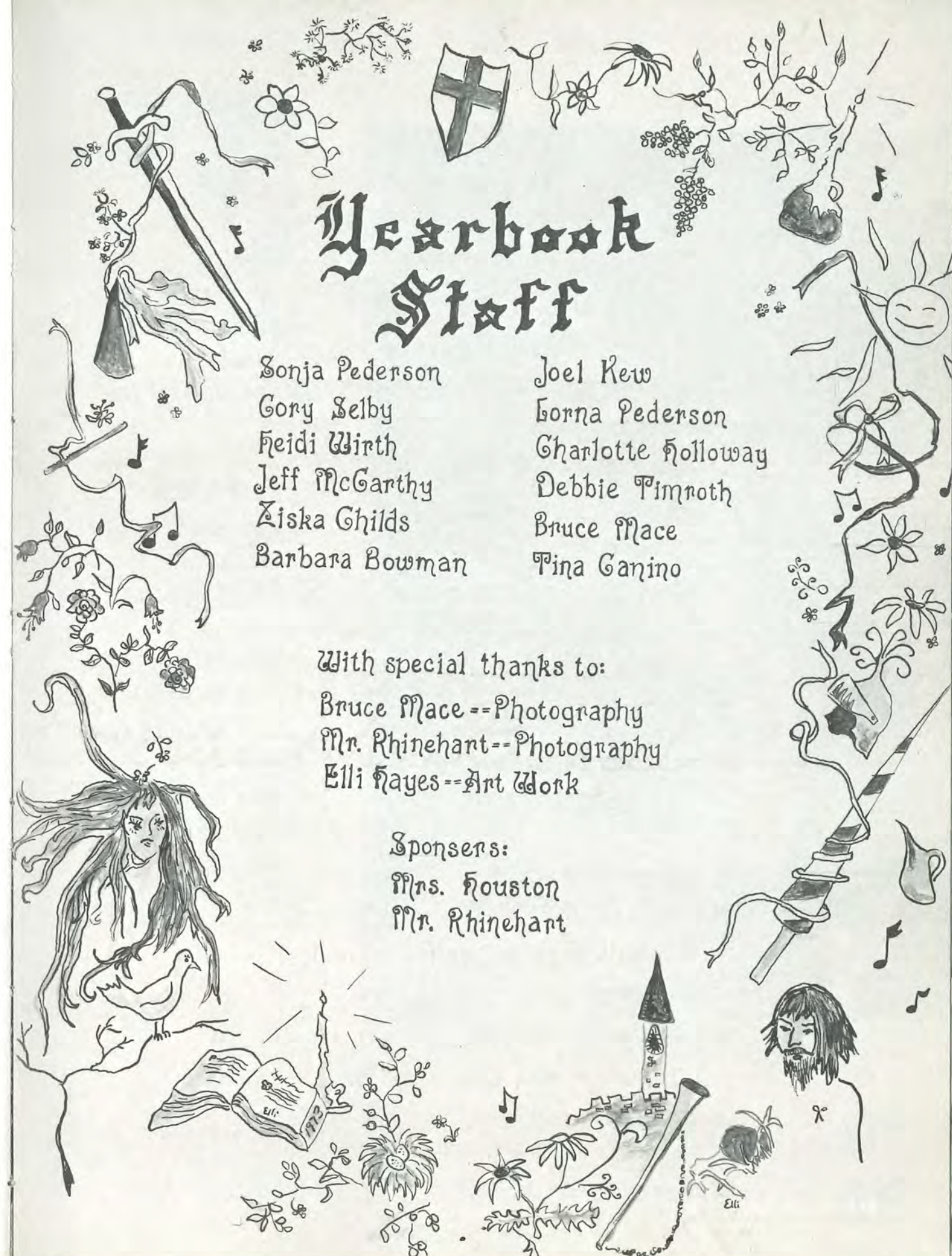
