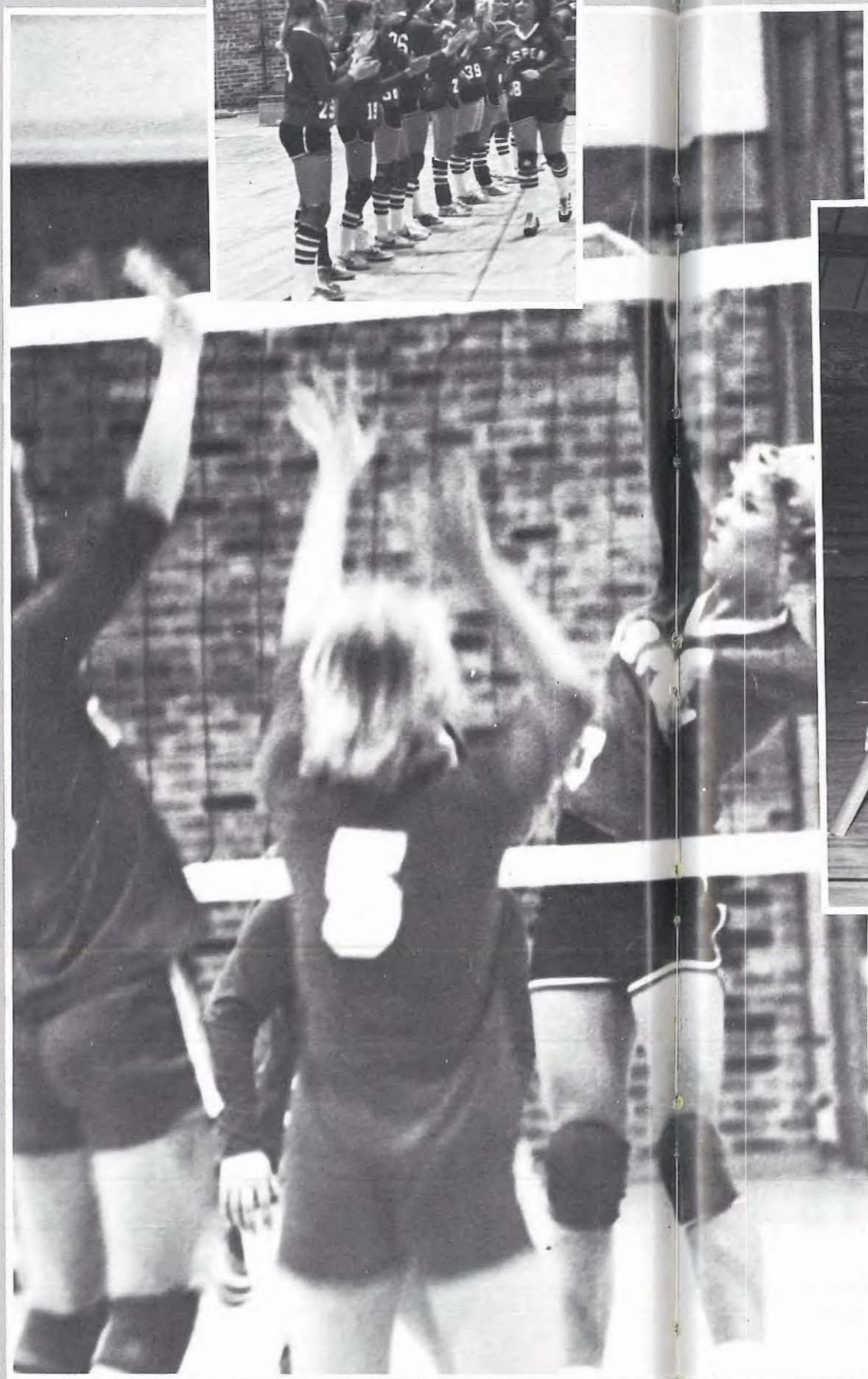
Aspen: Still Passin'

However, looking ahead to next year's team, we expect the current juniors to have developed their potential so that their 1981 season will be greatly improved.

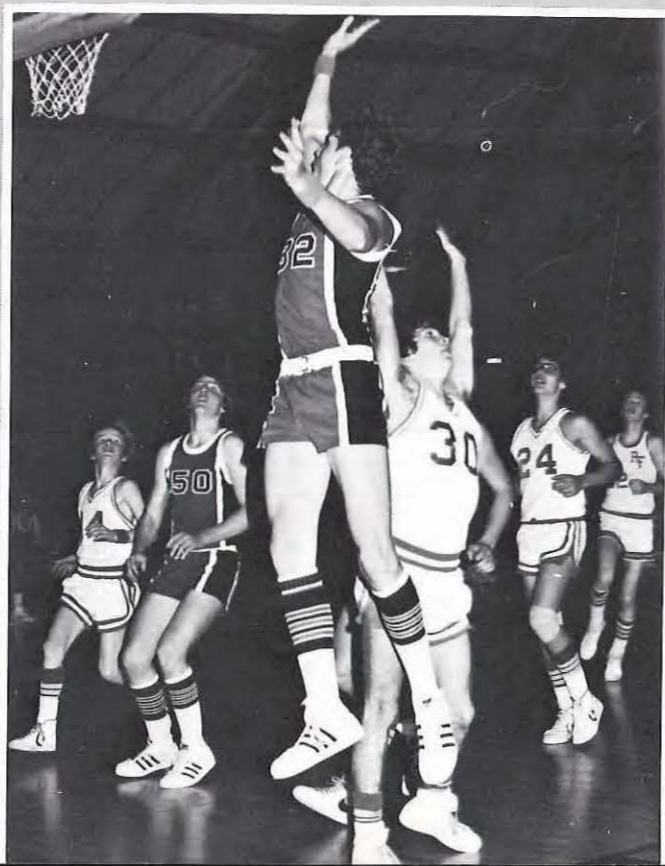
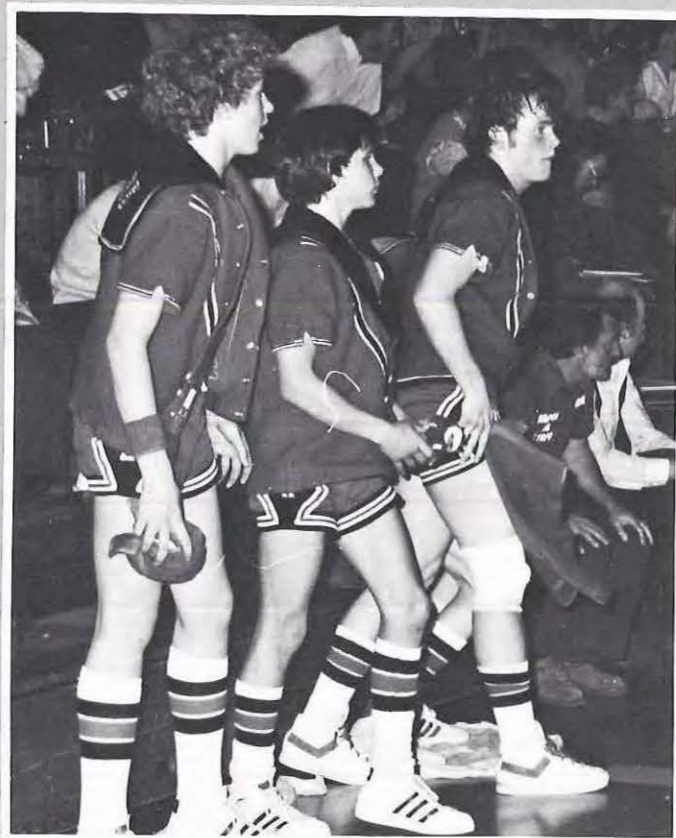
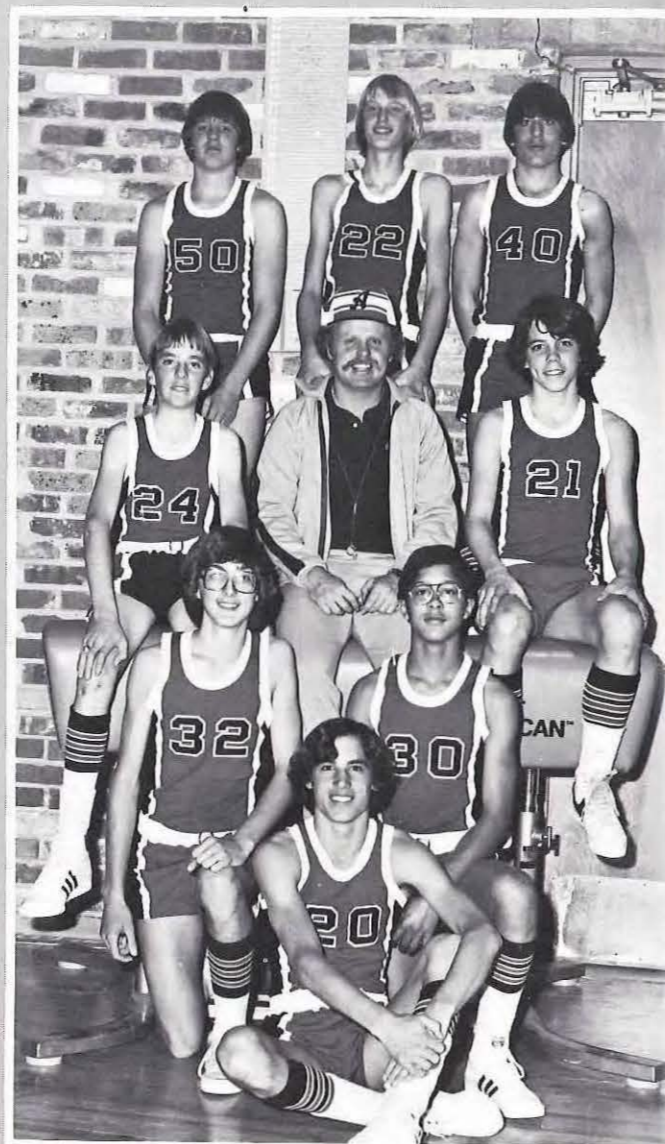
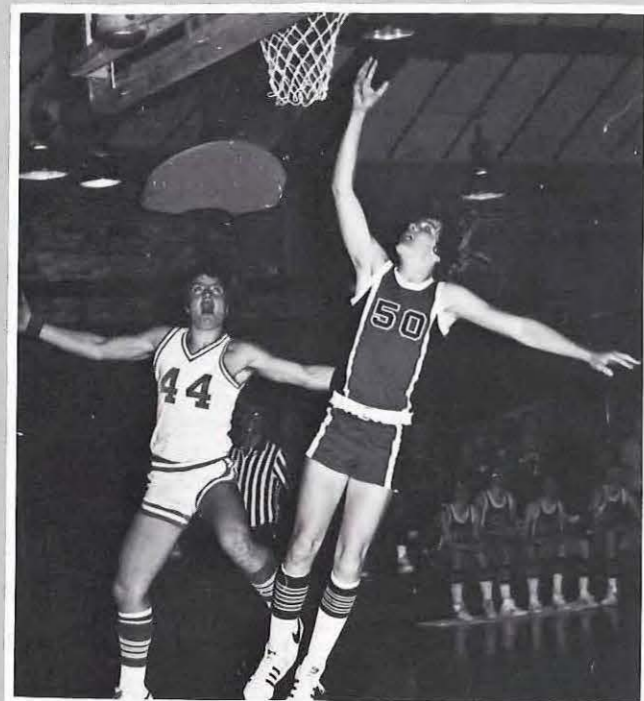
