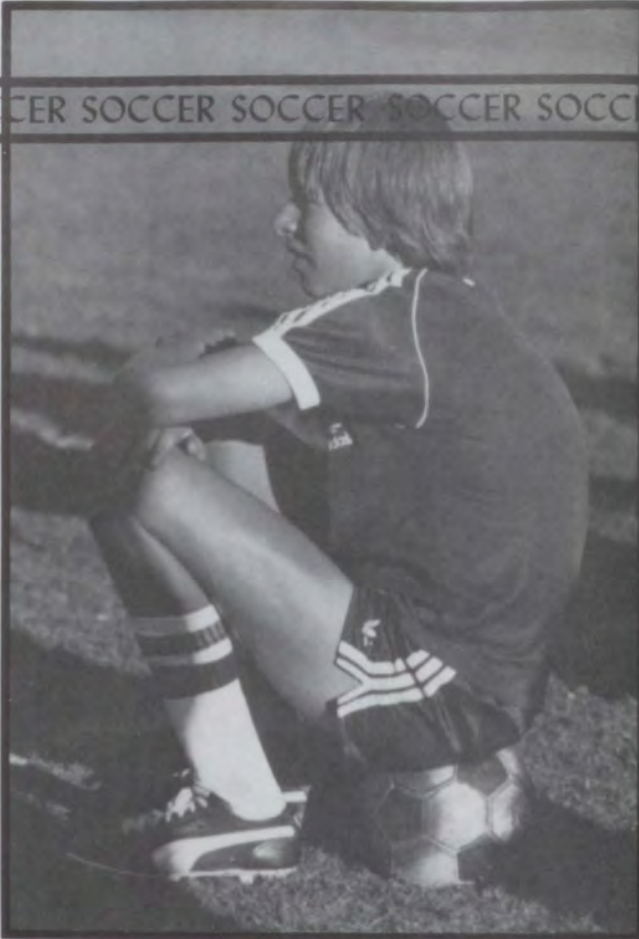
The women's team took second place in the League championship. Jill Anderson (5th) and Laura Shuldener (6th) won individual medals. The team placed 7th in the State race.
